

Improvement in status of waste management since December, 2017

Segregation in percentage (%)

- ✓ Segregation started since December 2017 till date - YES
- Number of wards where segregation is happening,
 - 2 (Ward No. 5 & Ward no 27)
- Door to door (DTD) collection : 80%
- Collection efficiency (in %)100%
- Processing (recycling & treatment of wet/dry waste):
- Disposal: How much percentage is being disposed? : 60%
