Planning Stage

Work with the organisers from event planning stage

- Consult on materials
- Plan for reusable cutlery
- Provide the optimum number of workers
- Try to Reduce waste generated



Planning Stage – Costing and number of people

- Requirements
 - Timing of each sub-event. Ex: Wedding morning breakfast, evening reception
 - Number of attendees or guests who will be present at the venue
 - Tasks that are needed to be done Ex: house keeping, washing, waste management
- Worker count
 - Each worker gets to work in 8 hr, 10 hr or 12 hr slot
 - 10 hr and 12 hr slot is hosen only if the event is extended to night time beyond 9 pm
- Materials
 - Each worker will have a uniform, gloves, cap.
 - Dustbins are used for wet waste
 - Dry waste bags are used for dry waste
 - Cleaning materials are brooms, mops, cleaning solution
 - Eco-friendly materials are used for washing plates and glasses.

During the Event

- We have trained team who will segregate the wet waste and recyclable waste
- Washing of reusable utensils with eco-friendly soap
- Ensure entire venue is litter free





Post Event

 Wet waste is sent to bio-gas plant

 Recyclable waste is sorted, graded and sent

for recycling

Zero landfill

After the event a report is submitted to the customer with details of the waste generated and the disposed method

The report contains

- 1. Weight of wet waste
- 2. Weight of dry waste
 - 1. Bottles
 - 2. Paper cups etc
 - 3. Tetrapack
 - 4. Flex materials
 - 5. Other materials
- 3. Weight of cutlery
 - 1. Adike plates
 - 2. Banana leaves
