What is Faecal Sludge?

Non-networked systems

Decentralised

Different context; different properties

Wet / dry

Fresh/ decomposed

Mixed or separation of urine and faeces

Addition of non-faecal material

Why are measurements needed?

Problem quantification

Selection of process options

Recycle / reuse options

Plant design (detailed)

Process control

Compliance

Environmental impact (Life Cycle Assessment)

Risk Assessment (chemical, microbiological)

Sampling

Depends on the reason for analysis

- extraction
- homogenisation
- transport
- storage

Types of Analysis

Chemical

- pH, conductivity
- · Solids, moisture, ash
- nutrients, sulphur, carbon
- metals
- protein , carbohydrate, lipids

Physical

- thermal (specific heat, conductivity, calorific value)
- density
- Rheology
- particle size (screen, sieve, laser)
- Colligative (osmotic pressure, ionic strength, boiling point elevation, freezing point depression, vapour pressure)

Microbiological

- Ascaris
- standard bacteriological analyses

Reparation for off-site analysis

- preservation
- extraction
- concentration

- struvite precipitation
- nitrification
- evaporation
- membrane processes
- microbial fuel cell

Mixed sludges

- screening
- extrusion
- pumping
