A Shit Flow Diagram (SFD) is an easy-to-understand advocacy and decision-support tool that summarizes and presents what happens to excreta in urban areas in a concise report. An SFD goes beyond this visual representation to also include an assessment of the delivery of sanitation services in the town or city and a record of data sources.
