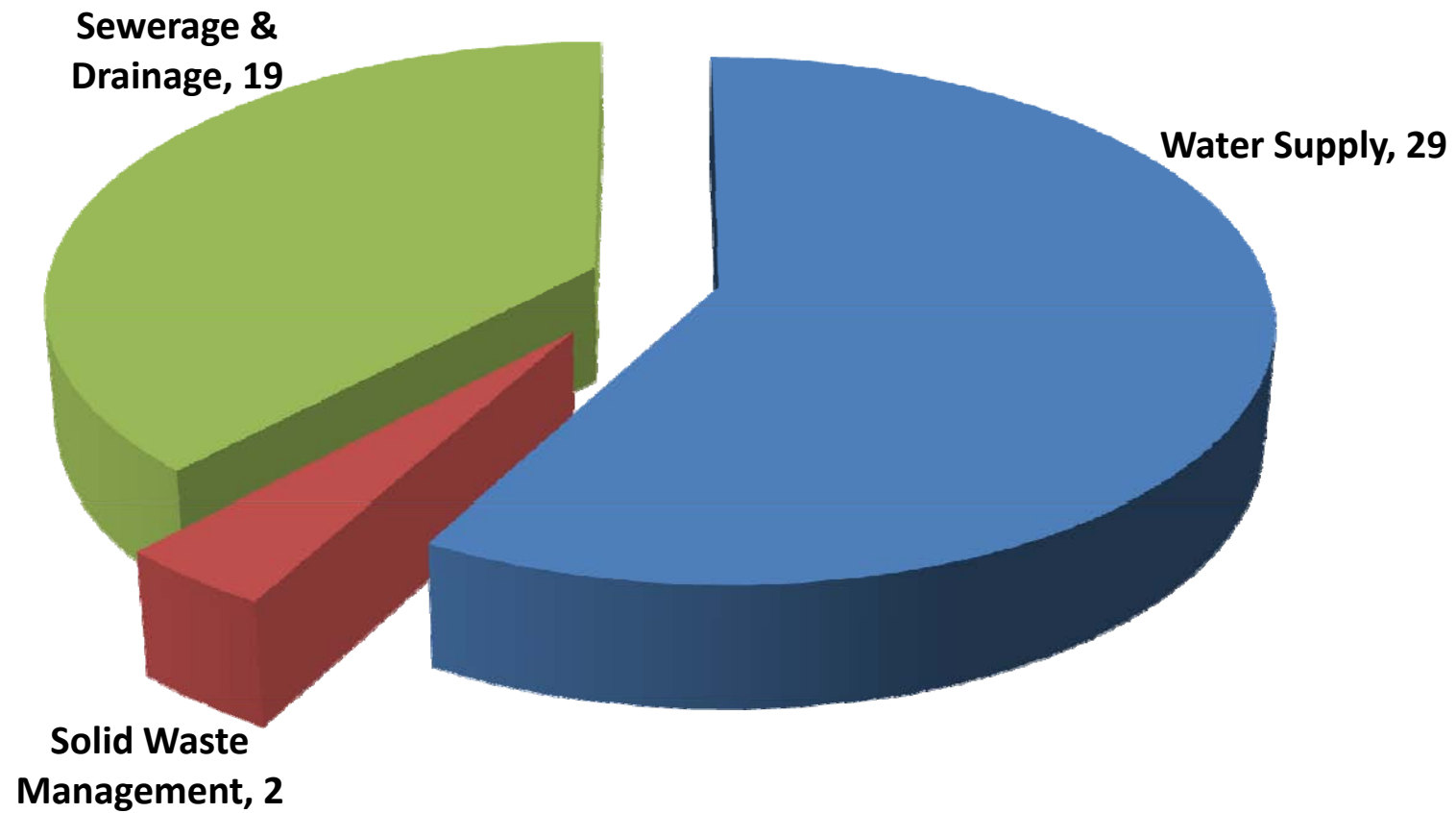

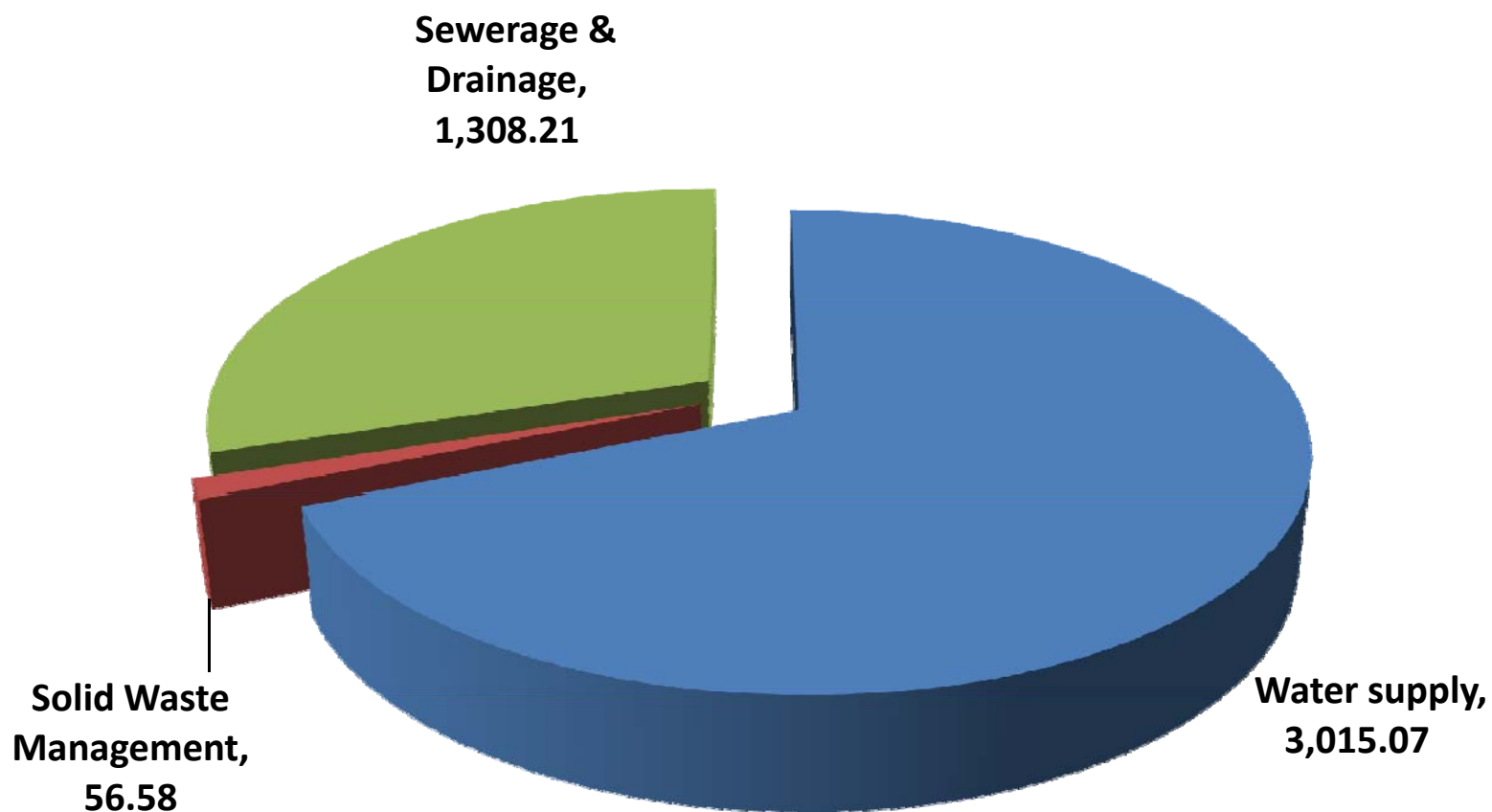
# Project wise breakup UIG

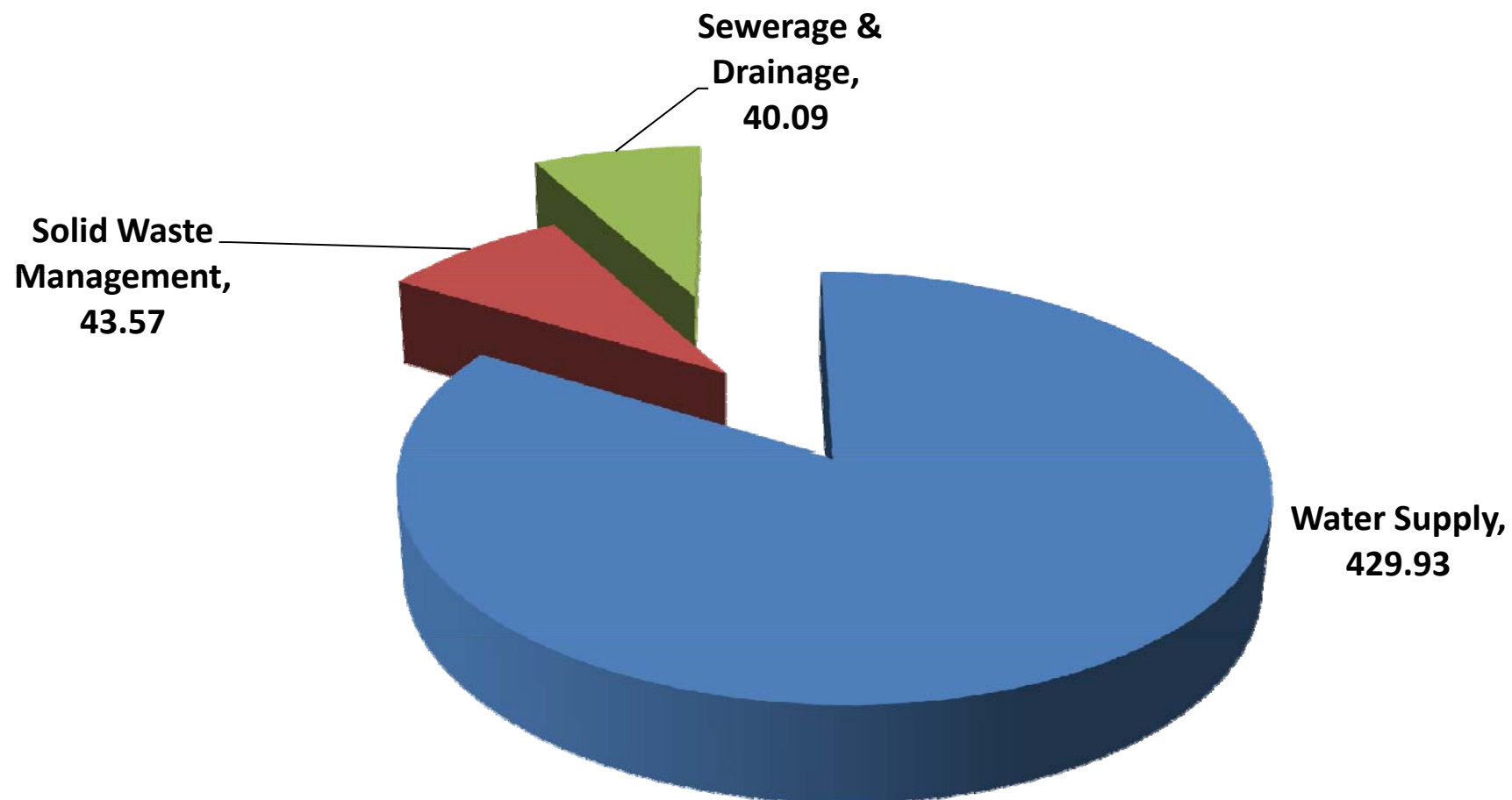

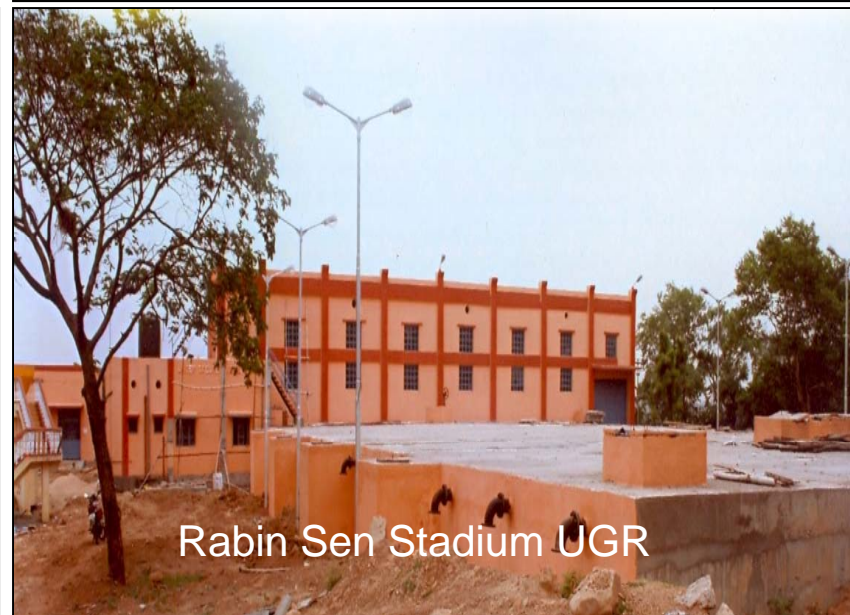

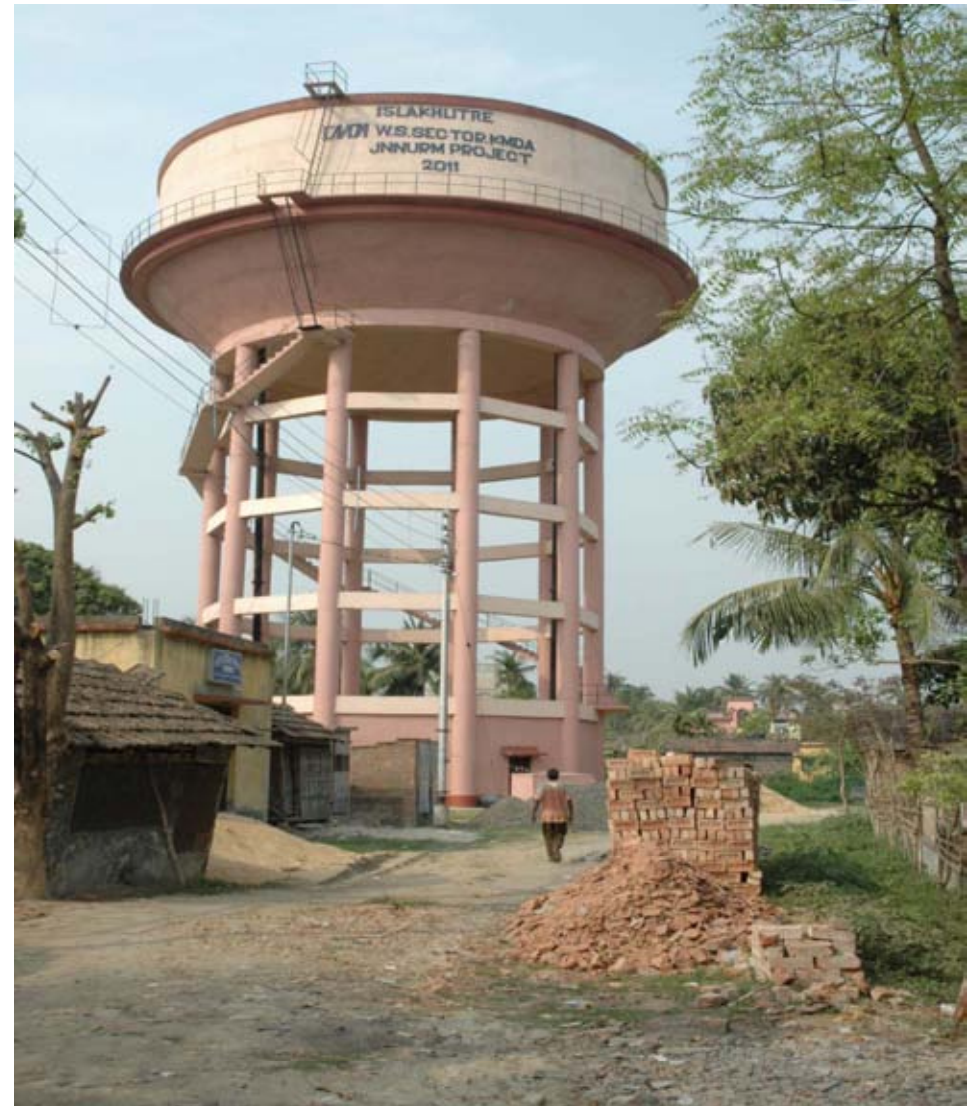

<b>Rationalization of Stamp Duty</b>	Under Implementation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stamp duty has been revised from 8% to 6% (2005-06) with effect from August 2006 in case of the properties situated in urban areas.</li> <li>• In case of properties situated in Kolkata and Howrah M.C. areas the additional surcharge of 2% has since been dispensed with. Therefore, in these two cities also, Stamp Duty has been now fixed at 6%. Proposal for further reduction to 5% is being examined by Finance Deptt.</li> </ul>
<b>Repeal of Urban Land Ceiling and Regulation Act</b>	Under examination of the expert committee	An Expert Committee was set up to examine the scope of repeal of ULCRA. Their report has been submitted to the State Govt. and presently under examination.

e-Governance set up	Partly Implemented	<p>In Kolkata Municipal Corporation, e-governance has been achieved. An integrated e-governance system was taken up under KUSP programme in 41 ULBs within Kolkata Mission City. Majority of modules have been made operational in these 41 ULBs.</p> <p><b>Asansol Mission City</b></p> <p>In <b>3 towns out of 5 towns</b> of Asansol Mission city, citizen centric services like birth-death registration, trade license etc. are also being done under e-governance on stand alone mode. Similar e-governance system is being rolled out. <b>Hardware procurement and Software installation is complete.</b></p>
