


Map of Kathmandu Metropolitan city

Existing Land Use of KMC


Integrated Action Plan of KMC in 2001 prepared the prevailing land use of Kathmandu.

Policy intervention on rainwater utilization in KMC

- Residential buildings with rainwater harvesting facilities will get rebate of 10% of building permit fee.
- Mandatory to install RWH with built up areas of 10000 sq.ft. or above.
- Promote groundwater recharge system in courtyard to control surface run off.
- Restoration and conservation of the traditional ponds to augment the ground water table
