



ONLINE TRAINING PROGRAMME ON

THE SANIPATH TOOL: ASSESSING EXPOSURE TO FECAL CONTAMINATION IN URBAN SETTINGS

Training Dates: 17-28 August, 2020 Study Hours: Online (12 Hrs) and Virtual (18 Hrs)

Centre for Science and Environment (CSE), India in partnership with Emory University, USA is organizing a online training programme on "The SaniPath Tool: Assessing Exposure to Fecal Contamination in Urban Settings". The tool aims to assess exposure to faecal contamination along multiple exposure pathways in urban, low-income settings. The tool guides users in collecting information on: a) where in the environment there

and b) how people come into contact with contamination in the environment. The tool includes a cloud-based platform to manage and monitor data collection in real-time and automatically conducts exposure analysis and synthesizes these data for community, government, and service providers' decision-making.

PROGRAMME DESIGN

Virtual sessions to be held on 17, 19, 21, 24, 26, 28 August between 17:30-20:30 IST.

The online training programme is based on state-of-art teaching – learning tools consisting of pre-session readings, videos, PowerPoint presentations, interactive discussion of concepts, group work sessions to practice data collection methods, and quizzes to assess comprehension of material.

Sessions will be held over a 2-week period with 3 days of virtual interactive training held each week (~3 hours each) and individual learning and assignments on remaining days.
