What is a green school?

Includes but not limited to:

- Window Floor Ratio (WFR) more than 5 per cent
- Majority population uses sustainable and/or non-polluting mode of transport
- Maximum use of energy efficient lighting and alternative sources of energy Minimising conventional lighting without compromising sufficient lighting for students
- High green cover inside and around school campus -- native species
- Cooked meals (no packaged foods that are high in Fats, Sugar and Salt)
- Rainwater harvesting (RWH) and reuse of treated wastewater
- Effective segregation of waste at source and responsible disposal
- Recycling at least 90 per cent of the waste
- Wet waste to be composted
- Waste not to be burned
