- Women regaining control over seeds



Mapping of Seed Diversity






















Community Seed Banks

Sahaja Seeds is s commercial wing of Sahaja Samrudha, linking seed conservation with sustainable livelihoods

Promotes, produces, and markets organically grown traditional and open-pollinated seeds


Works with farmer groups and FPOs to scale up indigenous seed production




