Participants will gain insights into environmental laws and acts, such as the Air Act (1981), Water Act (1974), and Environmental Protection Act (1986) as well as the board's responsibilities, which include granting consents, noting drafting, transitioning from polluting to cleaner fuels, ambient and stack monitoring, developing emission inventories, and promoting cleaner technologies like common boilers and other ways to reduce industrial air pollution.
