of plastic packaging to be reusable, recyclable or compostable\*

25%



average recycled content across all plastic packaging

3.

50%



of plastic packaging to be effectively recycled

\*These would only include compostable plastics with all the following properties: a) do not leave any microplastic residue, b) used in closed-loop and controlled systems with sufficient infrastructure available or fit-for-purpose applications, and c) properly labelled as 'Home' or 'Industrial' compostable

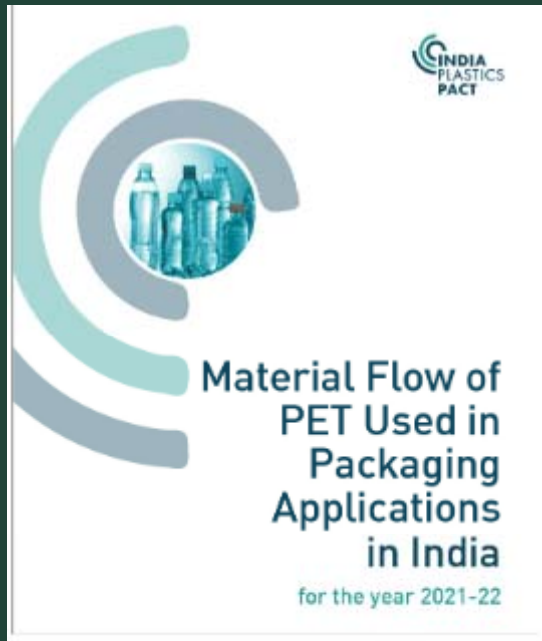
# Roadmap to 2030
