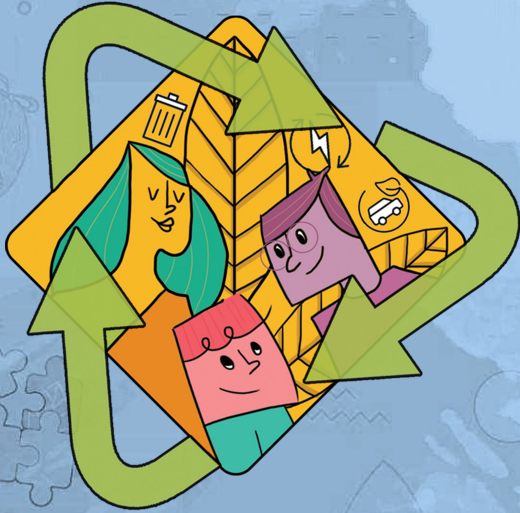
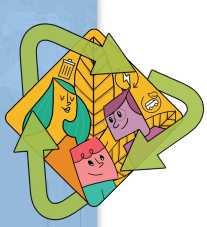

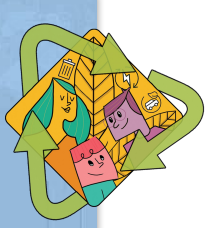

- Aims to build **understanding on marine litter** and empower students to act on it in their communities





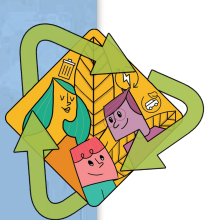
Who are Marine Marshals?



Student leaders... not just participants!

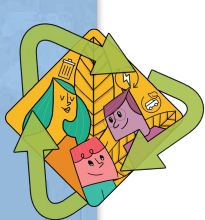

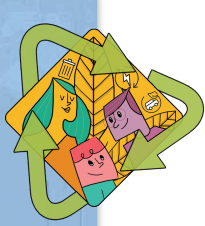

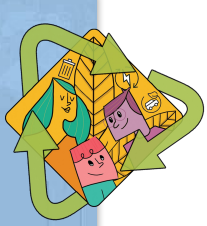
