Young Environmentalist (YE) and GSP invite school students to turn environmental stories into powerful musical performances! Raise your voices for the planet through music, poetry and storytelling to spread environmental awareness and inspire change for a greener future.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

- Choose one of the Gobar Times (GT) covers below for your performance.



- Create a 2-3 minute performance around the chosen theme in English or Hindi.
- Teams may perform either a musical, poetic or storytelling performance or a combination.
- Up to three musical instruments per team are allowed. **The GSP-YE team will not provide instruments.**
- Pre-recorded music or backing tracks are allowed.
- The performances will be evaluated on uniqueness, relevance to the theme and overall effect and audience interaction.

School teams must submit the script for their musicals by **January 21, 2026** to young@downtoearth.org.in with the subject line 'GSP Carnival: Echoes of Change'. Entries without a submitted script will not be considered.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The contest is open for students from Grades 6-12 from GSP network schools invited for the Carnival.

Schools can participate in teams of **up to four students**.

HOW TO REGISTER?

The GSP coordinator of the school must register the team via the GSP Carnival registration form.

Only the shortlisted entries will be invited for the final performance at the Carnival.

Winning teams will receive GSP goodies. Participation certificates will be awarded to each team.
