Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) and the School of Sustainable Urbanisation and Air Pollution under the Anil Agarwal Environment Training Institute (AAETI) announces an advanced course as part of its Green Campus Initiative. CSE is working with higher education institutions across India to enable teachers and students to transform their educational habitat by bringing efficiency in campus operations, instilling behavioural change in day-to-day practices and developing a culture of resource prudence and less wastage.

This course will train campuses to build their own integrated resource management framework based on five themes – energy,

land, water, air and waste. The focus of the training will be to equip campuses to collect and organise qualitative and quantitative environmental data. The framework also allows campuses to monitor and track their environmental performance over time and identify intervention areas for improvement.

The course aligns with the efforts of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and requirements of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). As the course will enable campuses to capture their relative performance and build a growth curve, it will also guide them in effective communication for green rating and preparation of self-study reports.

Course highlights:

- ◆ Data collection, interpretation and communication
- ◆ Development of resource repositories and baselines – energy, land, water, air and waste
- ◆ Risk assessment: determining likelihood and impact
- ◆ Performance monitoring and auditing
- ◆ Mandatory compliance requisites as per the Government of India
- ◆ Strategic and action planning for a green campus
- ◆ Exercises and case studies
