# MESSAGE FROM

## *Sunita Narain*

Director General, CSE

CSE's Green School Programme is a laboratory of practice. The objective is to educate the young through their actions – they walk the talk to understand sustainability. We believe that we learn best when we implement our ideas; when we measure what we have done and we set goals for what needs to be done next. This is what the Green Schools Programme (GSP) is about. It is pedagogy in action. It is learning by doing. And what is incredible is to see the change that the young can bring.

When we began the programme we had a few schools that joined; now we have more than 8,000 participating schools. Each school does an 'audit' of its environmental status. To do this, it creates a team that takes up the

challenge of measuring the use of resources, the consumption and wastage. The young team prepares a report card on the different indicators on each issue that makes up our environment – air, energy, food, land, water and waste. The GSP audit is a tool, designed by us, which students use for this report card. Every school that completes the Green Schools Audit gets a certificate, which is colour coded to tell them where they stand on their sustainability goal.

But it is not a static tool – the objective is to understand where you are and where you need to go. What are the actions that will take you up the ladder of a green school? This is where the real challenge is – to take action that will improve the environment.

Each audit leads to a performance report, which sets out the journey; in waste management to energy conservation. And each year, when the schools repeat the audit, they set new goals. They work on the areas that they have benchmarked as inadequate.

GSP uses an analytics platform to track the environmental performance of schools. With the data collected, we shift from counting inputs and outputs to helping schools measure sustainable impact over a period of five years. The data-driven indicators help participating schools track the environmental value of their work and understand their own impact within and outside their school premises. The environmental dashboard provides schools the baseline to quantify

their year-on-year environmental accomplishments with a richer, story-driven measure of impact. If schools fall short of the standards, they are guided to improve their environmental footprints.

This is how we get the category of ‘sterling’ schools. These are role model schools. Each ‘sterling’ school has been ranked as a green school for five consecutive years. This is not a small achievement by any measure. This means that schools have incorporated the practice of sustainability into their DNA. They have made it happen. They have used the practice for learning about the environment.

Most importantly, the Green Schools Programme shows that we can be the change we want to see in the world. It gives us hope; it gives us courage and inspiration.

# AN INTRODUCTION

The Programme, the Audit, and the Awards

**C**SE's Green Schools Programme (GSP) is an **innovative environment education**

**programme** for students, teachers and schools in India. It helps schools assess their use of resources and map their consumption and wastage across six key subject areas – air, energy, food, land, water and waste. The schools do this with the help of the GSP Audit, a formal tool designed exclusively for them.

Schools that successfully complete the Green Schools Audit become eligible for a 'Certificate' color-coded as Green, Yellow, Orange or Red, indicating their campus's sustainability rating. All participating schools receive a detailed performance report, encouraging them to enhance their performance in various sections. Schools can then submit the audit again in the following year to improve their ratings.



The novelty of this initiative lies in the fact that it moves beyond theories and textbooks and concentrates on 'doing' as well. GSP aims to subtly sensitise students towards the environment through hands-on and thought-provoking activities. It is also an environment management system that audits, through students, the

## **AN OVERVIEW AND TRENDS**

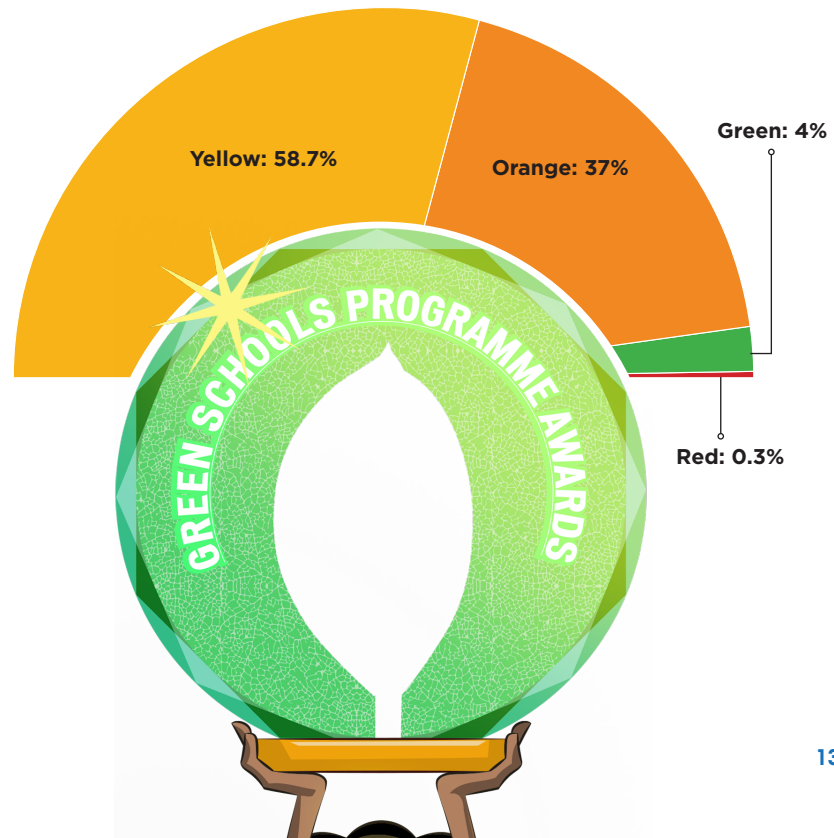
The GSP Audit 2025 saw a record-breaking participation of 8,831 schools from 33 states and Union territories.

**Like last year, Punjab maintained its lead as the state with the highest number of audit submissions.**

With the active efforts and participation of the Punjab State Council for Science and Technology (PSCST) and the district resource persons, schools were encouraged to carry out the GSP audit to assess their resource consumption across the six audit verticals. In order to make the process easier for teachers, the GSP team conducted a capacity-building session for district coordinators from all 23 districts of Punjab, who then played a key role in facilitating the audit exercise at the district level.

The district resource persons played a pivotal role in training teachers on various audit parameters, equipping them

with the skills to gather accurate school data and access relevant information effectively.

Punjab's remarkable performance in this year's audit was a testament to the collaborative efforts of stakeholders at all levels—district resource persons, teachers,

and students—bolstered by the unwavering support of PSCST. We extend our heartfelt congratulations to the entire Punjab team for their exemplary dedication and achievements!

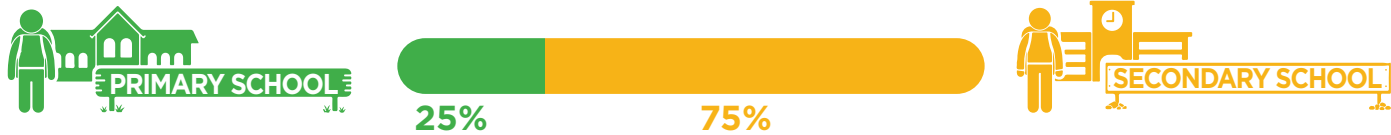
Looking ahead, the GSP team remains committed to the decentralised audit model,



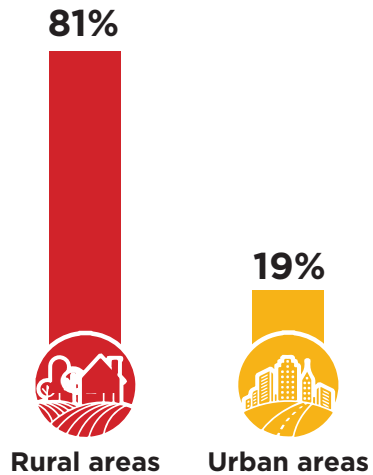
expanding its reach to schools across other states in the coming years.

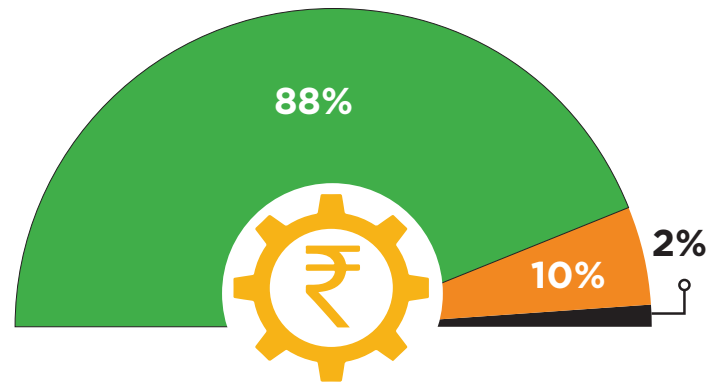

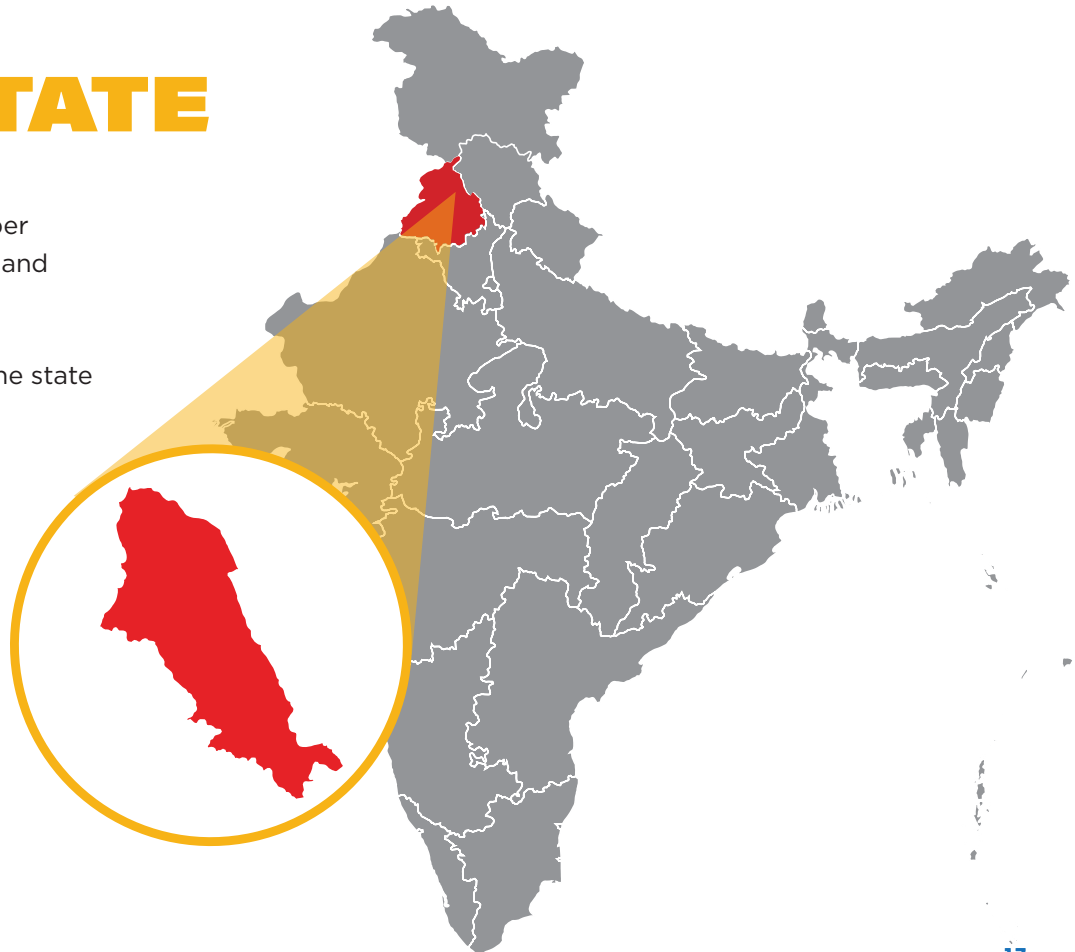

# THE CHANGEMAKER AWARDS

The Changemaker Awards are given to schools which improve their sustainability rating from yellow to green by monitoring and improving their practices over the year.



## CHANGEMAKER SECONDARY

### ★ **JP INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL** Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh

A co-educational institution with a population of 1330 students and staff, the school has remarkably improved its practices and infrastructure in the last year.

#### **AIR**

- Completely phased out diesel buses and transitioned to CNG
- School population using sustainable modes of transport increased from 64 per cent in 2023 to 70 per cent in 2024

#### **ENERGY**

- Introduced 115 kW rooftop solar plant. School is now almost completely solar-powered
- 100 per cent LED lighting on the campus

#### **FOOD**

- Kitchen garden with neem, tulsi, carom, tomatoes, guavas, lemons and chilli plants

#### **LAND**

- Increased unpaved area and used it to plant more trees
- Restored a green field adjacent to the campus

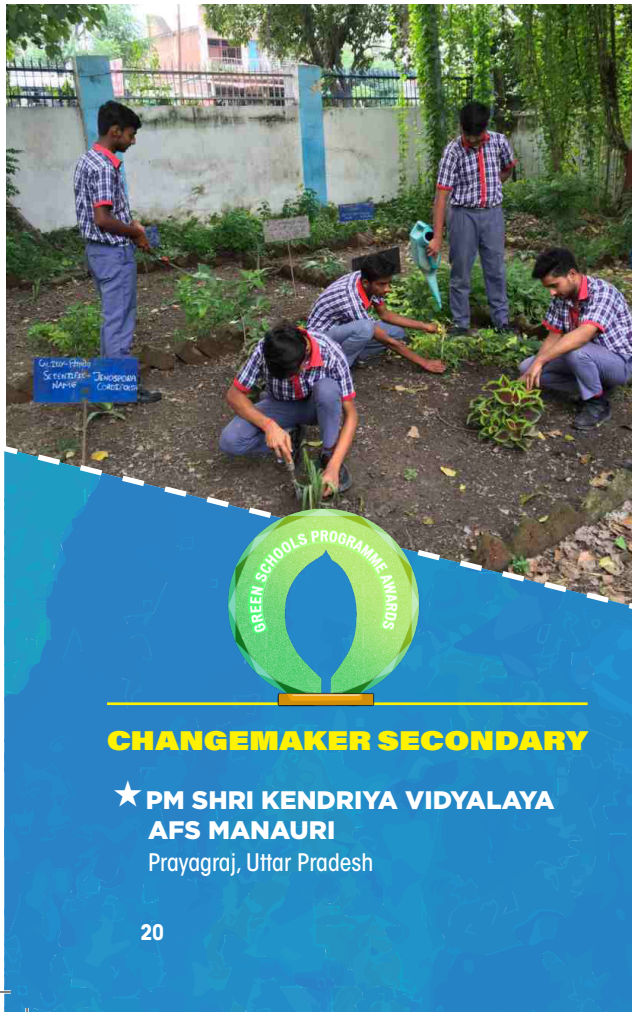
#### **WATER**

- Harvest rainwater from over 90 per cent of the school area and recharge groundwater

#### **WASTE**

- Increased waste segregation categories from three in 2023 to 7 in 2024
- Recycle 100 per cent wet and dry waste
- Adopted a village near school — old but usable furniture and plastic items are sent there





A government co-educational institution with a population of 2009 students and staff, the school has remarkably improved its practices and infrastructure in the last year.

### AIR

- Increased use of sustainable transport after awareness campaign by students — Two-wheelers reduced from 22 to 10, and four-wheelers from 10 to 4.
- Students coming by bicycle increased from 859 in 2023 to 1,147 in 2024.

### ENERGY

- The number of LED lights increased from 135 to 154
- Petrol and diesel completely phased out

### FOOD

- No packaged food is served in the school

### LAND

- Plants increased from 665 in 2023 to

1,488 in 2024

- Green area increased from 43 per cent to 50 per cent

### WATER

- Rainwater storage tanks increased from 1 to 4, with total capacity of 8,000L
- Catchment area increased from 30 per cent to 70 per cent.

### WASTE

- Waste segregation started with 3 categories and expanded to more than 3 categories.
- Collection points with two bins increased from 9 in 2023 to 176 in 2024
- 100 per cent recycling of wet waste

A government co-educational institution with a population of 853 students and staff, the school has performed remarkably in the air section over the past year.

- Around 100 per cent school population uses non-polluting or sustainable modes of transport
- Strict prohibition on diesel and petrol in school
- Burning of waste is completely banned
- Fully solar-powered campus



## OTHER ACTIONS

- Over 65 per cent green area
- Authorized dealers collect e-waste, ensuring proper disposal and recycling.
- Integrated environment education incorporated into classroom teaching
- 100 per cent wet waste composted on campus
- Promotes awareness of local food by having a kitchen garden in the school.



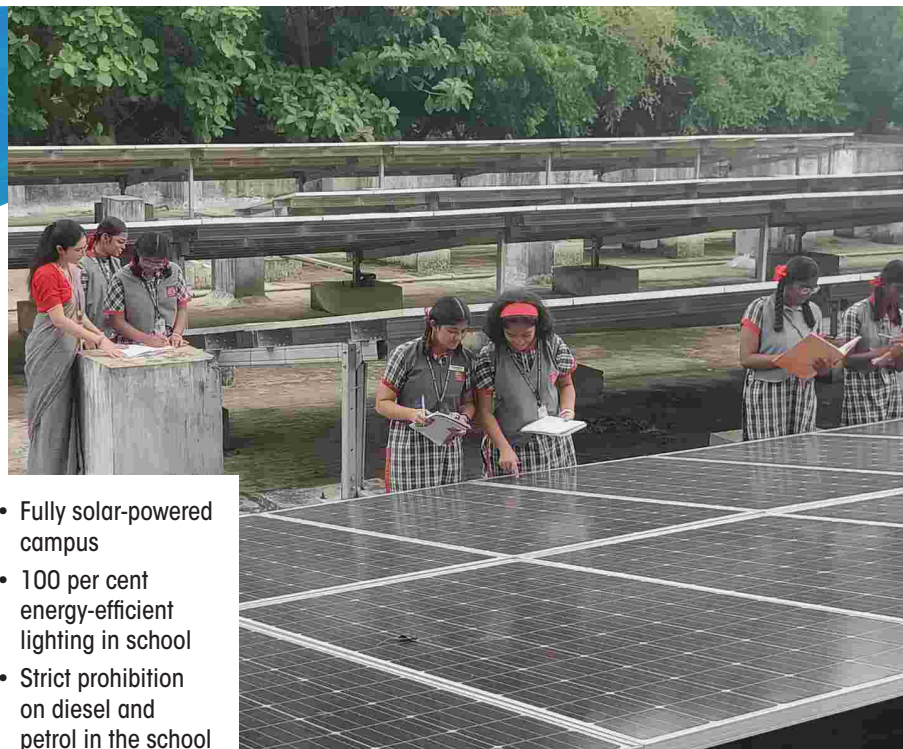




## ENERGY MANAGER AWARD

### ★ KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA IIT CHENNAI, TAMIL NADU

A government co-educational institution with a population of 1,823 students and staff, the school has performed remarkably in the energy section over the past year.



- Fully solar-powered campus
- 100 per cent energy-efficient lighting in school
- Strict prohibition on diesel and petrol in the school

### OTHER ACTIONS

- Practices rainwater harvesting through groundwater recharge
- Composts 100 per cent wet waste through natural and vermicomposting
- Authorized dealers collect e-waste, ensuring proper disposal and recycling
- No packaged food provided inside the school
- Reuses RO wastewater
- Environment education part of classroom teaching







## GOOD FOOD AWARD

### ★ **DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL** Pune, Maharashtra

A private co-educational school with a population of 4067 students and staff, this school has shown commendable commitment towards promoting good food practices. The notable initiatives of the school include:

- Complete ban on packaged food in the campus
- Three kitchen gardens spread over an area of 4865 sq feet
- Students play an active role in maintaining kitchen gardens
- Hydroponic system to conserve water, allowing for efficient growing techniques
- Millet of the month initiative - spotlight on a particular millet every month
- 100 per cent biodegradable waste converted to compost
- Wastewater from the kitchen used to water plants



## OTHER ACTIONS

- 1600 sq feet Miyawaki forest on the school campus, featuring 210 species of native trees
- Over 500 species of native plants and animals nurtured within the campus
- Flush less urinals installed in the junior wing toilets









## LAND MANAGER AWARD

★ **CAMBRIDGE SCHOOL**  
Indirapuram, Ghaziabad,  
Uttar Pradesh

A day-scholar senior secondary school with a population of 2,323 is giving its young learners a one-of-its-kind experience with organic farming in an urban set-up

- Developed 1890-sq-ft mini farm for students by students to practise organic farming
- Eight classes per month to learn and practice sustainable farming technique
- Students make bio-pesticides and bio-anti termites in-house for the farm
- Summer and winter produce is enjoyed by students and staff in the form of salads, pickles, and soups; students also take it home
- The wet waste from the farm is composted in the campus
- Herbal garden — completely maintained by students — in which they grow mint, basil, giloy, rosemary, etc.



## OTHER ACTIONS

- Nearly 50 per cent green area
- Three rainwater storage tanks of 15,000L capacity each
- Treat and reuse wastewater inside the school
- Zero waste collection points with mixed waste





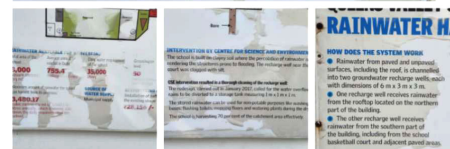
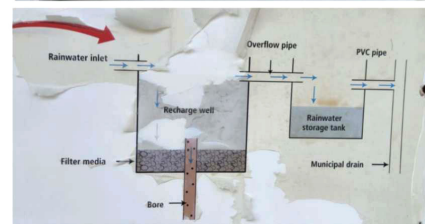
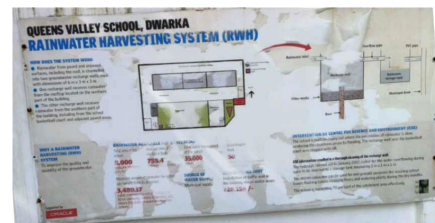


## WATER-WISE AWARD

### ★ QUEEN'S VALLEY SCHOOL Dwarka, New Delhi

A girls' school with a population of 2,583 students and staff, the school's noteworthy water conservation initiatives made it stand out.

- Comprehensive rainwater harvesting system with over 70 per cent of the school area harvested
- Two underground rainwater storage tanks with a capacity of 1,00,000 litres
- Rainwater being used to recharge groundwater for more than 8 years
- School maintains a water-efficient garden using drought-resistant plants and sprinkler irrigation systems
- Greywater system to reuse water from sinks and washing machines for irrigation and flushing toilets
- Reduced dependence on groundwater for non-potable purposes
- Water efficient fixtures such as dual flush systems, float valves and low flow faucets to minimize water wastage



## OTHER ACTIONS

- 100 per cent source segregation - no mixed waste bins in the school
- Over 95 per cent biodegradable waste converted into compost
- Almost 50 per cent green area
- 95 per cent of the school population uses sustainable or non-polluting modes of transport





## WASTE WARRIOR AWARD

### ★ **PINEGROVE SCHOOL** Dharampur, Solan, Himachal Pradesh

A co-educational residential school in the hills, with a population of 676, is managing all streams of waste effectively

- Segregates waste into seven categories as indicated in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016
- 100 per cent source segregation
- Waste effectively collected & managed from dorms, classes, kitchen, etc.
- 100 per cent recycling of wet and dry waste
- Biomedical waste sent to CBWTF for disposal; sanitary waste incinerated
- Plastic waste sent to cement factory for disposal
- E-waste sent to authorised dealer for management



### OTHER ACTIONS

- 64 per cent green area in school
- Sewage treatment plant on campus for reusing wastewater
- 30 kW solar rooftop plant
