About Bamboo in CFR Area

- Before CFR the bamboo was given on lease to Ballarpur Paper Mill by forest department.
- Paper mill was given the only wages for bamboo cutting to villagers. Rate was 18 Rs. per bundle (10 bamboo each bundle).
- Now, Gram Sabha themselves cutting the Bamboo and selling to the Ballarpur Paper Mill at rate of 95 Rs. per Bundle. Gram Sabha giving villagers 70 Rs. for cutting of Bamboo per bundle and 20 Rs. per bundle will be deposited in Gram Sabha's account as village community fund.

About Tendu Leaves

- Tendu collection & sale by CFR Gramsabha was started in 2015 first in some CFR villages in Gondia, Yavatmal and Melghat area in Amravati district.
- 80 CFR Gram Sabha in Korchi Taluka come together and formed a Taluka level Fedration known as Mahagramsabha Korchi Taluka.
- Under the guidance of Korchi Mahagramsabha, all Gram Sabha come together and auction their Tendu leaves from 2017.
- Four time increased in the income of every family through Tendu leaves collection.
- In 2016 forest department was doing the auction of Tendu leaves collection rates was 250 Rs. for 100 bundles (each bundle contain 70 Tendu leaves).
- After CFR, Gram Sabha auction the Tendu leaves by themselves there is continuously increased in the rate of Tendu collection.
- This year 2022, CFR Gram Sabha received 1130 Rs. per 100 bundles of Tendu leaves.
- This year each family (5 members) get income near about 25-30 thousand rupees from Tendu leaves collection.

New Plantation by Gram Sabha in CFR area

- 5 Gram Sabha of Korchi Taluka done new plantation of bamboo, Jamun, mango plants near about in 100 Acre's.
- There is decrease in incidence of forest fire in last 5 years.
- 9 Gram Sabha preparing their conservations & management plan with the help of Tribal Research and Training Institution (TRTI), Pune.

New Initiation from District Collector Gadchiroli for Capacity Building of CFR Gramsabha

- Gadchiroli district collector formed district transformation centre. The president of this centre is district collector.
- Through this centre district collector is doing agreement with each CFR Gram Sabha for Capacity Building of Gramsabha member about CFR.
- This centre done the agreement with Gondwana University Gadchiroli as knowledge partner.
- Uptill now, district transformation centre done agreement with near about 150 CFR Gram Sabha.
- Gondwana University planned 14 days training program for CFR Gramsabha members (5 members participate for each CFR Gramsabha 3 male and 2 Female members).
- First 7 days residential training is organize in university campus and next 7 days training in their own village.
- Up till now the training of 3 batches of 30 CFR Gramsabha's (150 members) is completed.

FRA Act 2006/2008/2012 - Rule 4 (f) Function of the Gram Sabha

- 1) The Gram Sabha shall: -
- (f) Monitor and control the committee constituted under clause (e) which prepare a conservation and management plan for community forest resources in order to sustainably and equitably manage such community forest resources for the benefit of forest dwelling Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers and integrate such conservation and management plan with the micro plans or working plans or management plans of the forest department with such modifications as may be considered necessary by the committee.

Preparation of Conservation & Management Plan for village CFR area

- Tribal Ministry of Maharashtra and Tribal Research & Training Institute (TRTI) in Pune done Triparty agreement with 72 Gram Sabha in Gadchiroli district & 2 Gram Sabha from Chandrapur district for preparation of conservation & management plan.
- In Triparty agreement was done between TRTI Pune, Gramsabha and Local CBO's.
- TRTI sanctioned 1 Lac 77 Thousand Rs. for each Gram Sabha for preparation of C&M Plan and deposited 1st installment of 53 Thousand directly into Gramsabha account.
- Local CBO's Amhi Amchya Arogyasathi, Vrikshamitra, Srusti and Paryawaran Mitra giving non-financial support.

Tribal Department of Maharashtra passed GR that CFR Gram Sabha work as Agency for MGNREGA and majority of MGNREGA work will be in community forest resource area (30th November 2021)

- Every CFR village open separate account MGNREGA
- Independent Gram Rojgar Sewak will be selected by Gram Sabha
- Incentive for Gram Rojagar Sewak will be paid by Gram Sabha.
- Two person selected by CFR Gram Sabha.
- District Administration train these person as barefooted technician.
