The Star Rating Programs

The Star Rating Program is a public disclosure program that will improve the environmental performance of industries by publicly recognizing the industries that are performing the best.

High-performing industries are rated with 5-stars (and low-performing industries with 1-star)—thereby encouraging greater responsibility and competition between industries to reduce emissions.

Example of Odisha Star Rating Program calculations

Rating	Range of mean PM Emissions	Data Availability from Monitors	Rating key	Representation
5 Star	<=50%	--	Very Good	
4 Star	50%- 75%	--	Good	
3 Star	75%- 100%	--	Moderate	
2 Star	100%- 125%	--	Poor	
1 Star	>125%	<85%	Very Poor

- Covers 137 industries from 6 sectors across 30 districts and 12 regional offices in Odisha.
- Data collected through **Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS)**.
