What is Green Schools Programme (GSP)?

- **Environment education initiatives** for a network of 20,000+ schools
- GSP offers online courses, capacity building workshops, masterclasses & learning resources to schools, teachers & students
- The flagship initiative GSP Audit — a vertical-based exercise — helps schools assess and improve their environmental practices to bring about a **measurable change**

A tool to assess the extent to which a school is observing sustainable 'green' practices

WHY GSP Audit?

- A tool for schools to **benchmark** resource consumption
- Makes positive environmental change '**measurable**'
- **Year-on-year** assessment of improvement and impact
- Engages students in **hands-on** activities to build knowledge
- Equips teachers to foster **environmental literacy**
- Helps school management with **efficient utilisation** of resources



AIR

- Window-to-floor ratio of classrooms
- Vehicle ownership and fuel-use pattern
- Commuting practices adopted by school





ENERGY

- Different sources of energy used by school
- Total energy consumed by school
- Renewable sources: Usage, maintenance and output





FOOD

- Food served in school premises
- Food habits promoted by school
- Tracking physical growth of students





LAND

- Total site area, land management and green cover
- Green cover: areas covered by grass, trees, lawn or horticulture, flower beds, shrubs etc., playground area covered by grass.
- Plant and animal species in school
- Vertical gardens, pesticide usage





WATER

- Water sources and total consumption
- Water conservation practices; rainwater harvesting
- Sanitation practices in school





WASTE

- Waste generation & segregation as bulk generators
- Total waste recycled or treated
- School policy and practices for waste management





What's in it for a school?

Sustainability rating on a four-point scale

Personalised feedback, user dashboard, reports and certificates

E-certificate of participation to all students and teachers

Annual **awards** ceremony to felicitate 'greenest' schools



GSP Dashboard

- Personalised dashboard for every school
- Year-on-year performance tracking

- Go through previous reports if you have submitted the audit before
- Response report, performance report and digital certificates
