The Centre for Science and Environment's (CSE) Green Schools Programme (GSP) works with schools, teachers and students across India to foster a deeper understanding of climate change, its causes and impacts, and the practical solutions that can help build a more sustainable future.

Building on the overwhelming response to the 2025 Green Schools Programme Audit and the continued participation of schools across Punjab, the Centre for Science and Environment (CSE), in collaboration with the Punjab State Council for Science & Technology (PSCST) under the Environment Education Programme of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), is organising the 4th CSE-PSCST State-Level Orientation Workshop.

The three-day residential workshop is designed for teachers and district coordinators nominated by PSCST. It aims to strengthen environmental education in schools by building participants' understanding of the Green Schools Programme, the GSP Audit framework and practical approaches to integrating sustainability into school education.

THE VENUE

CSE's state-of-the-art residential training facility, the Anil Agarwal Environment Training Institute (AAETI), is located in Nimli, Rajasthan, at the foothills of the Aravalli Hills, approximately a three-hour drive from Delhi. The campus itself serves as a living laboratory of sustainability, offering participants the opportunity to experience resource-efficient infrastructure and environmental best practices firsthand.
