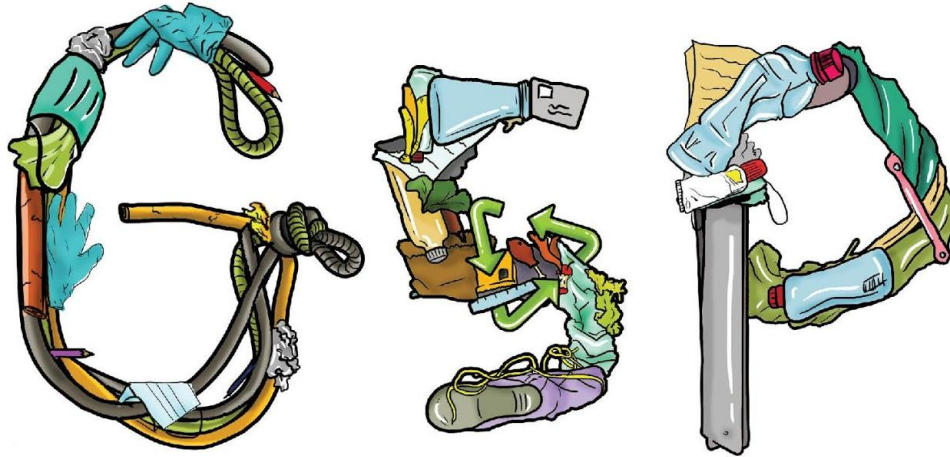

# Why was the action plan needed?

1. For constant awareness in our society
2. To minimize classroom solid waste
3. Proper use of solid waste
4. Only **45 per cent** of 35 kgs of dry waste is processed





# Action Plan

1. Awareness campaigns will be held at regular intervals.
2. Daily data monitoring of classroom solid waste, **weighing and displaying data on board.**
3. Solid waste will be managed by 5 R's method: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Recycle





# Indicators to assess action plan

1. People become more aware and conscious about environment.
2. Gradual reduction in classroom waste and increase in processing of dry waste from **45 per cent to at least 75 per cent**
3. Green budgeting and businesses are generated
