
In view of the COVID-19 outbreak following precautions need to be adopted for smooth operations of Decentralized Wastewater Treatment System (DWWTs)

In addition to the regular O&M instructions of DWWTs



Things to keep in mind before visiting the plant.



>>> Wear full sleeve clothes to cover the body.



Ensure to have all the PPEs likeGloves, mask, jacket, gum boots,face shield or safety goggles etc.



Ensure to keep sanitizer



We bandage for any kind of cut or wound to prevent its contact with the wastewater.



In case of cold or flue symptoms, immediately consult a doctor and avoid visiting the site.



>> Wash your hands properly with soap at least for 20 seconds.

Things to keep in mind during the plant operations



» Do not touch unnecessary things.



» Sanitize your hands properly, before and after touching any object.



» Wear proper PPEs (gloves, mask, jacket and face shield or safety goggles) during the work.



» Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with your hands.




» Avoid consuming food at site.



» DO not smoke and spit at site.



>> Use waterproof gloves to avoid cuts or wounds coming in contact with wastewater.



Maintain a minimum safe distance of 1 m with your colleagues at site.



» Use lime powder as a disinfectant in case of spillage or leakage of wastewater at site.

Things to keep in mind after plant operations



Used equipments to be sanitized or fumigated properly before keeping it back.



» Dispose off masks and gloves at designated bin, In case of reuse, wash with warm water and sun dry.



» Sanitize gum boots, helmet and safety goggles after every use.



» Sanitize phone, purse etc daily.



>>> Wash your hands properly with soap at least for 20 seconds.




» Keep used clothes separately for washing and don't mix with other clothes.



>>> Ensure to take bath after returning from workplace.



Wash used PPEs and clothes using 0.05% chlorine solution and sun dry.



Note: Routinely consult a doctor and as per recommendations,
