Sub : **Issuing an order for obligatory reuse of certain percentage of Construction & Demolition waste (C & D waste).**


Ref : **Workshop of ULBs on C & D waste management.**

I would like to draw your kind attention to the fact that the Construction & Demolition waste management is one of the key focus of the National Clean Air Action plans. Hence, it is required to focus on the strategy for dust control and management generated from the C&D waste. While it is necessary to understand and share the experience on ecosystem approach to C&D waste management including methods for estimation of volume of C&D waste, it is also necessary to have policy and mandates, infrastructure development for collection, segregation and transfer, processing technologies monitoring and enforcement.
