plead 'guilty' or 'not guilty.' Every charge — under IPC section 302/24 (murder with common intent); section 201/34 (destruction of evidence with common intent); and, section 201 (giving false information with regard to an offence committed) which applies only to Rajesh — was read out. To each, the Talwars said "we will face trial". ENS

Bauxite mines: 10 km from National Park on paper, NTCA says 1 km in reality

Govt-approved mines near Sahyadri Tiger Reserve under scanner

TWO bauxite mines at in Udgiri near Chandoli National Park, part of the Sahyadri Tiger Reserve in Kolhapur district have come under the scanner of the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA). The mines have government approval to operate 10 kilometres from the National Park boundary but an NTCA assessment shows they operate around a kilometre from it in violation of a Supreme Court order.

The NCTA has raised queries with the state forest department about permission given to the mines.

The environmental clearance letter given to the mines, M/s Swati Minerals and M/s Prakash Anand Rao Gaikwad (Gawandi) in Udgiri by the Union Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) in December 2006, a copy of which is with The Indian Express, states, "It is noted that Chandoli National Park is located 10.0 km from the mine lease just outside the buffer zone."

NTCA Assistant Inspector General Ravikiran Govekar said they visited Sahyadri Tiger Reserve in October 2011 and found the mines operating within a kilometre of the National Park perimeter. "NTCA has written to the state forest department about irregularities and violations by the mines. It should be probed," he said.

Govekar said the situation was the same when he had visited the sites earlier this month. "So far, our office has

not received any compliance report from the state government or the forest department. There is a provision to suspend or cancel permission to the mines if found to have been given on the basis of wrong information," he said.

Honorary wildlife warden Ajit Patil of Sangli and activist Nana Khamkar of Creative Nature Lovers, Karad, have taken up the issue with a Central Empowered Committee (CEC).

Committee member-secretary M K Jiwrajka had issued a notice to the principal secretary (forests), Maharashtra government on April 12, 2012, saying "pursuant to the SC order dated 4.8.2006 in writ petition (civil) No. 202 of 1995, no mining operations are permissible within 1 km of the boundary of the nearby National Park.... pursuant to the order of SC, all proposals for grant of environmental clearance for mining leases falling within 10 kilometres from the boundary of the National Park need clearance from the standing committee of the NBW (National Board of Wildlife)... the matter may please be looked into..."

Khamkar said, "We requested the empowered com-

mittee to see if there is a violation of SC orders in giving sanction to the mines. It should be probed whether the distance between the mines and the National Park was verified by government agencies or not when MoEF clearance was given in 2006. It should be checked whether the mines have taken clearance from NBW. Noise from the mines disturbs wildlife in the tiger reserve. The approach roads to these mines are through forest areas under Kolhapur territorial range."

When contacted, Principal Secretary (forests) Pravinsinh Pardeshi said he will look into the matter. Pardeshi said, "We will review the case. No new permissions were given for mining in the last two years or so. But there are old permissions, given earlier."

Meanwhile, P A Golangad of M/s Swati Minerals said, "We are not doing anything illegal as we have all permission and clearances from the government. We take care that forests are not disturbed." A representative of M/s Prakash Anand Rao Gaikwad mine said, "We initiated the process for obtaining the mining lease in 2003. In 2006 we got MoEF

clearance, which is obtained after verification of distance and other facts by government agencies."

District mining officer, Kolhapur, Vijaykumar Salvi said they received copies of the MoEF clearance for the mines. When asked if his office had verified the distance between the mines and the National Park, Salvi said, "We have followed all procedures."

Chief conservator of forests (regional) P N Munde said, "Udgiri mines are located on revenue land and not forest land. We are not looking into the case." Chief conservator of forest (wildlife) Mohan Karnat was not available for comment.

Assistant Conservator of Forest S L Zure confirmed they had given a report a few months ago that part of M/s Swati minerals operates within 1 km of the boundary of the National Park and M/s Prakash Anand Rao Gaikwad mine at slightly more than 1 km. Both are located in the proposed buffer zone of the Sahyadri Tiger Reserve.

FIR against cricketer quashed

THE Delhi High Court on Friday quashed the FIR lodged by US citizen Zohal Hamid, who had accused Australian cricketer Luke Pomersbach of molesting her and assaulting her fiancé. Justice M L Mehta said no purpose was going to be served by continuing with the case since the complainant and accused were foreigners and now wanted to go back after settling the complaint.

"Let them go back to their respective countries. Let it be a happy ending after they say they have compromised and consider this to be an unfortunate situation. Nothing remains to be adjudicated after their settlement. Since they resolved the dispute and wanted to go back to their respective countries, I allow their prayer to quash the FIR," said Justice Mehta. During the proceedings, Hamid, Luke and Sahil Peerzada per-

sonally requested the court to get the FIR quashed and averred that the incident occurred due to a "misunderstanding".

Citing "mutual misunderstanding and discord," Pomersbach along with Hamid and Peerzada had moved the court jointly a day before and sought quashing of the criminal case lodged against the cricketer under molestation and assault charges. The three made the plea, terming the incident leading to registration of the FIR "unfortunate" and saying that they have amicably settled their disputes and wished to end it.

Pomersbach, playing for Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) in IPL, was arrested on May 18 after Hamid alleged that he had molested her in a five-star hotel and beaten up her fiancé. Pomersbach was later released on bail on the condition that he would not leave the country or contact Hamid. The trio said they mutually decided to end all their disputes.
