



COURSE TITLE: Mainstreaming Sustainable Urban Water Management

30th Nov - 4th Dec 2015, Venue: Kenya Water Institute (KEWI) Nairobi

Introduction:

The Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) in collaboration with Kenya Water Institute (KEWI) is organizing a five day training programme on “**Mainstreaming Sustainable Urban Water Management**” in Nairobi, Kenya.

The programme combines two trainings namely- rainwater harvesting and decentralized wastewater treatment including local reuse.

Course Objectives:

- To provide knowledge, skill development and attitude change of participants towards sustainable water management
- To capacitate participants for planning, designing and implementing low cost decentralized water and wastewater management at different scales
- To share experiences on existing and upcoming policies and practices from India and South Asia on urban water management.
- To build south-south network of practitioners (state/non-state) for mainstreaming sustainable water management practices

Course Content:

Decentralized Wastewater Treatment (DWWT) and Reuse



The training will include understanding characteristics of domestic wastewater, principles of DWWT systems, hands on experience in planning, designing implementation of DWWTs at different scale, and operation and maintenance and monitoring DWWT systems.

Urban Rainwater Harvesting (RWH)

This programme will focus on urban RWH and the potential it holds in augmentation of water availability by using public spaces to recharge their groundwater or store and reuse the rainwater



Target Participants:

Professionals including Engineers, architects, urban planners and geologists from government organizations and all water sector companies in Kenya, non-government organizations, academic and research institutions

Course Costs:

Kenya Water Institute (KEWI) will meet the expenses for the course but participants are supposed to take care of their travel and accommodation expenses.
