Please review decision on distillery: Sunita

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Noted environmentalist and director-general of the Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) Sunita Narain has termed the Kerala government's permission to set up a distillery at Muthalamada in Palakkad as a case of "insensitivity and lack of thought".

ment to review the decision.

"This is a double injury for the people of Muthalamada because a distillery that had been closed down because of pollution is being allowed to reopen in a place where people were so angry about the pollution caused by Coca-Cola.

"The decision to set up distillery at Muthalamada does not make sense," she said.
